

These code requirements are not specific to Illinois School Code or Illinois Administrative Code, but are mandated as part of the Illinois Department of Public Health Code.

### **Health Examination Schedule**

Proof of health examination and proof of immunization against preventable communicable disease are required upon entry to kindergarten or the first grade level a school offers, prior to entrance into nursery school, upon entering sixth grade (not 5<sup>th</sup> grade - effective 8/24/07) ninth grade, and upon first entry into any school.

Dental exams are required by May 15 of the student's second and sixth grade years. Vision examinations are recommended but not required. Tuberculosis (TB) exams are required by the Department of Health when the child involved resides in an area that has a high incidence of TB.
