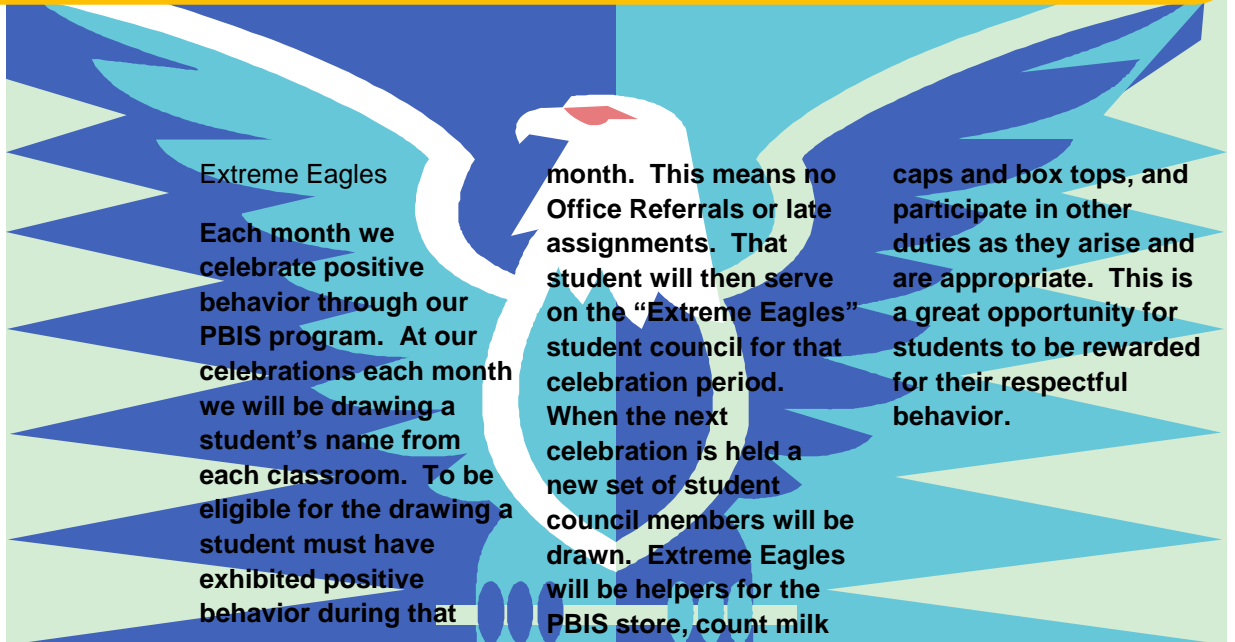

Each month we celebrate positive behavior through our PBIS program. At our celebrations each month we will be drawing a student's name from each classroom. To be eligible for the drawing a student must have exhibited positive behavior during that

month. This means no Office Referrals or late assignments. That student will then serve on the "Extreme Eagles" student council for that celebration period. When the next celebration is held a new set of student council members will be drawn. Extreme Eagles will be helpers for the PBIS store, count milk

NEWS FROM THE NURSE

The cold and flu season is just about upon us this year, and I thought this would be a good opportunity to let you know the Mercer County School's policy about when to keep your children home for illness.

If your child has had a fever of 100 degrees or higher, they need to be 24 hours free of that fever **before** returning to school.

If your child has vomited or had diarrhea, they should be 24 hours free of those conditions **before** returning to school.

The best defense against the flu or a cold is to drink plenty of fluids, rest and keep your hands washed.
