All students entering Kindergarten must have a physical, an eye exam and see the dentist before entering school for the first time.

The school nurse will be able to answer any questions you may have about the health requirements. Immunizations must be up to date also.

At 6:00, Mrs. Whitehall and Mrs. Olson will have a short presentation on expectations for Kindergarten. During this time, Mrs. Leopard will have story time with the children in the library.

At 6:15, the children and their parents

will meet to have a tour of the kindergarten classrooms.

After the tour, parents and children will then go back to the Activity Room to get their health packets and fill out some papers for the office.

Each student will need a certified copy of their birth certificate to be able to start school and you may bring it with that evening if you have it.

This is just a preliminary meeting to acquaint you with the school. You will need to join us again in August for the regular registration.

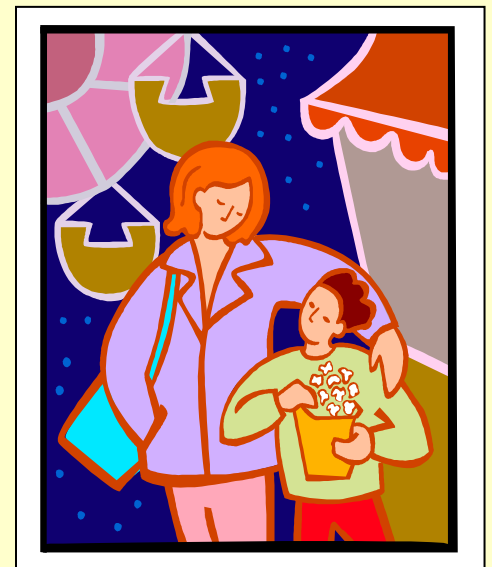
CATCH THE FUN!!!!

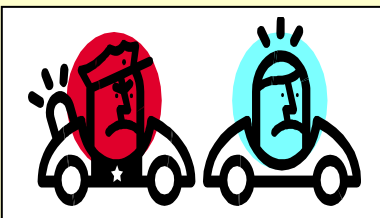
There will be various booths set up in different parts of the school, mainly in the Activity Room and the Gym.

Bus Notes



Here is a reminder about the buses.

Did you know if you are apprehended passing a school bus while it is stopped (with the STOP arm extended) you could face fines, and/or loss of driving privileges. This is a state law and the consequences of passing

the stopped school bus is determined on how many tickets you have had within a period of time.

Please use caution when you approach a stopped bus. The buses are loaded out the south school door (across from the ball diamond). If you pass the bus, while they are loading (with the stop arm out, you could be fined.
