

After School Assistance Program

MCIS offers *after school assistance* for students who require “extra” help with their core classes. This program is designed to provide direction for students who struggle with homework completion and organization. The classroom teacher, parent, or administration may recommend students for *after school assistance*.

A teacher or one of our aides will be present to help with student needs in specific areas such as Math, Literature, English, Science, and Social studies. There is no charge for the class.

Students MUST come prepared with classroom work/assignments that require “hands-on” assistance and/or a book to read if homework is completed. Students may read an AR book, but only after they have completed their homework and had it reviewed by the tutor in charge. They must also be able to work on their own for short periods. A good attitude and a desire to work are a must for this program to be successful. Like all school programs, our school rules do apply.

The “*After School Assistance Program*” is on Tuesdays, Wednesdays, and Thursdays. It begins at 3:00 and ends at 4:00. Students are expected to sign in when they arrive and sign out when they leave. There is no “*After School Assistance Program*” on early dismissal days.

Transportation will be provided with drop-offs at Joy, Keithsburg and New Boston.
