If your child isn't feeling well and needs to stay home, we encourage you to reach out to their healthcare provider and follow their guidance about when it's safe to come back. If you have any questions or need to share a health update, please contact your school nurse. Together, we can help keep our classrooms healthy and our students learning!

# **Post-Secondary Visits**

Juniors and Seniors may use a total of three attendance days to visit post-secondary schools. Forms may be picked -up in the counselor's office and must be returned to the main office at least one day prior to the visit, for the absence to be excused. Keep in mind that most post-secondary schools have special fall preview days on Saturdays and encourage parents/students to make private appointments if they cannot attend a preview day. Several colleges are currently offering scholarships to students who attend the preview days. Scholarship eligibility is often based on a qualifying essay or drawing.




