SAT Test Free for All Juniors—April 17th

This year our juniors will be taking the SAT test for their college entrance exam. The state of Illinois has contracted with the College Board SAT for schools to administer the SAT to all juniors at no cost to the school. All colleges and universities will accept the SAT and/or the ACT score. On Wednesday, April 17th all juniors will take the test at the Mercer County High School. When testing is finished around 1:00 pm, the juniors will be free to leave for the day. Khan Academy is a free practice site for the SAT and all juniors should have an account where they can get on and practice test questions, test sections, or take a whole SAT test. Freshmen, Sophomores, and Seniors will be Remote learning on the 12th.

The Freshman and Sophomores will be taking the PSAT 9 and 10 on April 10th.

Students may register on-line at www.act.org and use a credit card for payment. RE-MEMBER to include Mercer County High School's code 140008 on the registration information so the school has your ACT scores for your transcript. Keep in mind that the ACT can be taken multiple times & colleges do not care if scores go down on retakes. Colleges will not pull the highest scores from multiple dates but do take the highest scores from one single test date regardless of the number of times the test has been taken. **Fee waivers are available if you qualify.
