## Mercer County High School Homecoming Parade Rules and Regulations

- 1. All entries are required to exhibit proper decorum and family oriented behavior in the staging area and during the parade.
- 2. Throwing or shooting items such as gifts, candy, or water during the parade is prohibited.
- 3. Walkers <u>may</u> distribute items to the crowd. Do not do anything to encourage spectators to enter the parade vehicle path.
- 4. Autos and large vehicles must be driven by a licensed driver.
- 5. Any driver under age 18 is required to have the signed permission of a parent or guardian.
- 6. Keep within 20-30 feet of the entry in front of you. Do not stop during the parade, except to keep your spacing or in case of emergency.
- 7. All pets must be on leashes.
- 8. Please be sure to communicate these rules to everyone in your parade entry.
- 9. Any deviation from the rules will result in disqualification from current and/or future parades.

Please note: the parade route will remain the same as last year. The parade route will head <u>East</u> on W. Main Street, with lineups beginning on  $4^{th}$  Avenue –  $8^{th}$  Avenue. It will be VERY IMPORTANT for you to check

your email and let those in your entry group know of the correct line up. I will do my best to have an email out before Noon on Wednesday, Sept. 24th, of which complete directions will be included.
