MINUTES

1. Facility study status update

- i. Facility study is currently in 'draft' status. The document is approximately 240 pages.
- ii. A brief summary was discussed for each building
- iii. Remaining needs:
 - Room designations are needed for the Junior High building
 - Attendance boundaries are needed for each of the buildings in the district if available as either a map or description

2. Needs assessment summary

- i. Faculty/staff survey results summary is incorporated into the facility study. 59 survey responses have been received to date.
- ii. Faculty/staff interview sessions to be determined

3. Discussion of options for optimal configuration

- i. Ten (10) preliminary options for configuration were presented to the group.
- ii. As a result of discussion, consensus is for the following:
 - K-5 building in central location within district is high priority
 - MCIS is the best solution for a middle school
 - The high school and Joy junior school are in need of significant repair. These buildings must be addressed in any solution.
 - Future options for consideration:
 - a. K-5 Elementary in Joy (either new building or addition to existing gymnasium and locker rooms)
6-8 Middle School at current MCIS in Aledo
9-12 High School – existing building to be renovated/updated
 - b. K-5 Elementary in Joy (new building or addition to existing)
6-8 Middle School at current MCIS in Aledo
9-12 High School – new building on property of MCIS/Apollo with existing auditorium/gymnasium/lockers to remain as community/events center
- iii. Discussion of options yielded the following comments and questions:
 - Cost will play a large part in the decision making
 - Long bus routes are a concern with any solution
 - A single elementary makes most sense for this district for economy, efficiency of operation, efficiency, and effectiveness of delivering curriculum

- a. Two separate elementary buildings don't make sense for this district
 - b. Currently class sizes tend to be larger at Apollo and smaller at New Boston. It is difficult to balance class sizes due to the distance between these centers.
 - c. Question was raised as to the possibility of continual adjustment of attendance center boundaries to help balance class sizes.
 - d. Question was raised as to the possibility of keeping two buildings for K-2 with a separate 3-5 building.
- The current 5-6 intermediate configuration is not quite the right solution for the district
 - Capital Cost vs Operating Cost is consideration. The reduction in quantity of buildings will reduce the annual operating cost for the district.
 - A centralized location for an elementary school is highly preferred
 - Having all elementary faculty/staff together will create optimal situation for collaboration, management, efficiency
 - More sections together in a single building will create ability to balance class sizes.
 - District consolidation in the past caused concern with bussing of students to other towns. This concern included long bussing duration, and fear of unknown conditions at different towns/buildings. However there does not seem to be a lot of concern now because this has been the norm for many years.
 - Attendance centers model at other districts has been highly rated
 - Most pressing district needs are currently the maintenance and repair concerns with the Joy Junior School and the Mercer County High School buildings
 - There is a desire to have top-notch facilities and technology within the district
 - The current MCIS is the best suited building for a 6-8 configuration, however it will need some additional classrooms.
 - The Joy Junior School building has a very good gymnasium. There is a desire to keep the gym and locker rooms and remove the rest of building, which would allow a new K-5 addition.
 - a. The Joy location is very central to the district
 - b. Busses are currently located in Joy
 - c. There is an abundance of space on the Joy property
 - d. The gymnasium is large, very useful and in good shape
 - e. Question over which part of the Joy building should be salvaged and which should be removed, however the gym is better space to retain
 - f. Keeping a building in Joy will be important to the community
 - A lot of students in New Boston are not close enough for walking. The buildings don't function predominately as 'walking' schools.
 - Question on the possibility of using the additional property adjacent to MCIS for creating a new high school. This would produce a campus for the district.

- a. It would be important to consider keeping the outdoor fields, auditorium, and gymnasium at the current location.
- There is a concern that money should be invested to resolve current/near-term issues at the high school and then look to the long range for new building construction.
 - There are water infiltration problems at the High School and Joy buildings that cause great concern.
 - The current high school auditorium was described as “Awesome.” It was recently remodeled, and there is emotion tied to that space.
 - There was question regarding the possibility of renovating/updating the existing high school, versus constructing a new building. Both options will be explored.
 - The most important priority is to create a solution for the 6-8 grade level. The second priority is creating a solution for the K-5 grades.
 - It was questioned if a quick solution can be developed to allow the MCIS to immediately handle the additional 7th-8th grade students and move the 5th grade students to Apollo and New Boston. It is felt that there is sufficient room at the current elementary buildings to handle additional students for a short period.
 - There is a desire to have a good plan for the district, not just a quick change. The preference is for a well thought out solution that will create the best long term benefit for the district.
 - Near-term versus long term: Solutions should be thought of as masterplan for the long term with possibility of multi-phased approach.
