### Safety Plans

Mercer County High School 21EAGLES Program funded through the Nita M. Lowey 21<sup>st</sup> Century Community Learning Centers Grant will adopt and follow all Mercer County High School and Mercer County School District #404 safety policies and procedures, in order to provide a safe environment while participating in extended school hour programming.

The 21EAGLES Program will follow all health recommendations/requirements set forth by the Illinois Department of Public Health, Illinois State Board of Education (ISBE), as well as the administration at Mercer County School District #404 for summer programming and for programming scheduled during the 2021-2022 school year.

The MCHS 21EAGLES Program will in case of accident, illness, or unacceptable behavior, call parents immediately. In serious medical instances, the students will be taken to one of the local hospitals for treatment by emergency vehicle and parents will be called as soon as possible. If you have a hospital preference, please make sure this is known and noted on the District Emergency Medical Consent Form.

Mercer County High School Fire Evacuation procedures, Tornado procedures, and Intruder/Hostage procedures are displayed in classrooms and areas in all High School buildings used by the 21EAGLES Program. 21EAGLES staff is trained and aware of these procedures through Mercer County High School drills as required by State, Local and District regulations. Students are aware of these procedures.

Mercer County High School 21<sup>st</sup> Century Community Learning Centers Grant can provide a Proof of Insurance Letter from the Regional Office of Education #33 for all off-campus trips and programming as needed. Sign-in/attendance sheets are used for all 21EAGLES Programming for all on and/or off-campus events.

It is our intent to provide a safe and supervised environment for all participants of the 21EAGLES Program at all times during programming, including transportation to and from programming there provided.
